**The North West Worcestershire Water Board (Charges)
Order 1973**

Made - - - 28th June 1973

Coming into Operation 1st July 1973

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 40 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the North West Worcestershire Water Board (Charges) Order 1973 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1973. Citation and commencement.

(2) The North West Worcestershire Water Board Orders 1962 to 1969 and this order may be cited together as the North West Worcestershire Water Board Orders 1962 to 1973.

2. During the period beginning with the coming into operation of this order and ending on 31st March 1975 the prescribed maximum charge for a supply of water by meter shall be 17·5p per thousand gallons instead of three shillings per thousand gallons as prescribed by section 34(1)(d) of the North West Worcestershire Water Board Order 1962(c). Alteration of meter charge.

3. For the purposes of this order, section 94 of the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945 (which requires copies of the special Act to be kept by undertakers in their office, and to be deposited with certain officers) shall apply to the undertaking of the North West Worcestershire Water Board and is hereby incorporated with this order. Application of section 94 of the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945.
