**The National Health Service Reorganisation Act 1973
(Commencement No. 1) (Scotland) Order 1973**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 58(3) of the National Health Service Reorganisation Act 1973(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the National Health Service Reorganisation Act 1973 (Commencement No. 1) (Scotland) Order 1973.

2. The following provisions of the National Health Service Reorganisation Act 1973 shall come into operation on 5th July 1973:

- (a) paragraphs 41, 138 to 140 and 142 to 150 of Schedule 4
- (b) the entries in Schedule 5 relating respectively to the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1947(b) and the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1972(c).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order—

- (a) brings into operation the provisions of paragraph 41 of Schedule 4 to the National Health Service Reorganisation Act 1973, under which Regulations made by the Secretary of State relating to the payment of compensation for loss of the right to sell a medical practice may provide for the interest payable on any amount of compensation to be paid at a later date than that compensation;
- (b) incorporates in the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1972 the minor and consequential amendments and repeals made by Schedules 4 and 5 to the National Health Service Reorganisation Act 1973.
