**WATER SUPPLY, ENGLAND AND WALES**

**The North West Sussex (Hardham Intake) Order 1973**

*Made* . . . . . 24th July 1973  
*Coming into Operation* . . . . . 1st August 1973

The Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the North West Sussex (Hardham Intake) Order 1973 and shall come into operation on 1st August 1973. Citation and commencement.

(2) The North West Sussex Water Orders 1959 to 1971 and this order may be cited together as the North West Sussex Water Orders 1959 to 1973.

2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires— Interpretation.  
“the Board” means the North West Sussex Water Board;  
“the Third Schedule” means the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945;~  
“the undertaking” means the undertaking of the Board as from time to time authorised by any enactment.

3.—(1) The Board may construct and maintain on the land described in Schedule 1 to this order an intake on the river Rother adjacent to and on the west side of the intake authorised by section 3 of the North West Sussex Joint Water Order 1950(c). Construction and maintenance of work.

(2) The work authorised by this order shall for all purposes form part of the undertaking.

4. For the purposes of this order, the provisions of the Third Schedule specified in column (1) of Schedule 2 to this order shall, subject to the modifications set out in column (2) thereof, apply to the undertaking and are hereby incorporated with this order. Application of certain provisions of Third Schedule.

SCHEDULE 1

DESCRIPTION OF LAND

Land belonging to the board at Hardham in the parish of Coldwaltham in the rural district of Chanctonbury in the county of West Sussex being part of the enclosure numbered 39 on the 1/2500 ordnance map of Sussex (West), sheet XXXVI. 6 (edition of 1911) comprising approximately 53 square yards.
