The Awards (First Degree, etc. Courses) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1973

The Secretary of State for Education and Science, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Education Act 1962(a) and vested in her(b), hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Awards (First Degree, etc. Courses) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1973 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1973.
- (2) In these regulations "the principal regulations" means the Awards (First Degree, etc. Courses) Regulations 1971(c) as amended by the Awards (First Degree, etc. Courses) (Amendment) Regulations 1972(d) and the Awards (First Degree, etc. Courses) (Amendment) Regulations 1973(e).
- (3) The Interpretation Act 1889(f) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. For the amount "£275" in paragraph 2(1)(a) of the Third Schedule to the principal regulations there shall be substituted the amount "£295".
