**The National Insurance Act 1972 (Commencement No. 5)
Order 1973**

The Secretary of State for Social Services, in conjunction with the Treasury(a), in exercise of powers conferred by section 6(5) of, and Schedule 4 to, the National Insurance Act 1972(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the National Insurance Act 1972 (Commencement No. 5) Order 1973 and shall come into operation on 10th August 1973.

Appointed days

2. The day appointed for the coming into force, in Great Britain, of any provision of the National Insurance Act 1972 specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order, so far as that provision relates to any subject matter specified in column 2 of that Schedule, shall be the date specified in column 3 of that Schedule in relation to that subject matter.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into operation, in Great Britain, the provisions of the National Insurance Act 1972 relating to the lower weekly rate of attendance allowance in the case of persons who are in Category 3 (i.e. born in any of the years 1898-1907) and Category 4 (i.e. born before 1898).

Under the Order, questions as to entitlement to the lower weekly rate of the allowance may be determined in the case of persons in Category 3 from 10th August 1973 and in the case of persons in Category 4 from 11th August 1973, but the allowance will not become payable before 1st December 1973 in the case of persons in Category 3 and 3rd December 1973 in the case of persons in Category 4.
