The Isles of Scilly (Historic Buildings) Order 1973*Made* - - - - - *2nd August 1973**Coming into Operation* *5th September 1973*

The Secretary of State for the Environment, upon the application of the Council of the Isles of Scilly and in exercise of powers conferred by section 292 of the Local Government Act 1933(a) and now vested in him(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Isles of Scilly (Historic Buildings) Order 1973 and shall come into operation on 5th September 1973.
2. This order shall be read and construed as one with the Isles of Scilly Orders 1943 and 1957(c).
3. The Council may exercise and perform the functions conferred on local authorities by the Local Authorities (Historic Buildings) Act 1962(d).
