# The North West Worcestershire Water Board (Barrow Hill) Order 1973

Made

10th October 1973

Coming into Operation

22nd October 1973

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:---

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the North West Worcestershire Citation and Water Board (Barrow Hill) Order 1973 and shall come into operation on commence-22nd October 1973.

- (2) This order shall be included among the enactments which may be cited together as the North West Worcestershire Water Board Orders 1962 to 1973.
  - 2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires:—

Interpretation.

"the Board" means the North West Worcestershire Water Board; "the deposited plan" means the plan prepared in duplicate signed by an Under Secretary in the Department of the Environment and marked "Plan referred to in the North West Worcestershire Water Board (Barrow Hill) Order 1973" one duplicate of which has been deposited and is available for inspection at the principal offices of the Board and the other at the offices of the Secretary of State for the Environment;

"the Third Schedule" means the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945;

"the undertaking" means the Water undertaking of the Board for the time being authorised by any enactment.

3. For the purposes of this order, the provisions of the Third Schedule Application which are specified in column (1) of Schedule 1 to this order, subject to the of provisions modifications specified in column (2) thereof, shall apply to the undertaking of Third Schedule. and are hereby incorporated with this order.

4. The Board may, when they have acquired the necessary lands or Construction obtained sufficient interest therein—

and maintenance of

(a) construct and maintain a borehole (to be known as the "Barrow works. Hill borehole") on or under the lands described in Schedule 2 to this order:

(b) construct and maintain on or under the said lands (in addition to the works authorised by section 4 of the Third Schedule as applied to the undertaking by this order) all such additional boreholes, wells, adits and headings as may be necessary or expedient for augmenting or improving the supply of water obtainable by means of the said borehole.

Works to form part of undertaking.

5. The works authorised by this order shall for all purposes form part of the undertaking.

Part IV (Minerals underlying Waterworks)	In section 12 for the words "after this section is incorporated with their enactments" there shall be substituted the words "under the special Act"; for the words "all existing pipes or other conduits for the collection, passage or distribution of water and underground works belonging to them" there shall be substituted the words "all such pipes or other conduits or underground works"; and the words "for the time being belonging to them" shall be omitted.
