**The Cromarty Firth Port Authority Order 1973 (Commencement
No. 1) Order 1973**

Made - - - 12th December 1973
Coming into Operation 1st January 1974

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 1 of the Cromarty Firth Port Authority Order 1973 confirmed by the Cromarty Firth Port Authority Order Confirmation Act 1973(a) and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Cromarty Firth Port Authority Order 1973 (Commencement No. 1) Order 1973.

2. In this Order “the Order of 1973” means the Cromarty Firth Port Authority Order 1973 confirmed by the Cromarty Firth Port Authority Order Confirmation Act 1973.

3. The provisions of the Order of 1973 specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall to the extent specified in column 3 of that Schedule come into operation on 1st January 1974.
