The Park Lane Improvement Scheme Orders Revocation Order 1973

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 4(3) of the Park Lane Improvement Act 1958(a) and now vested in him (b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Park Lane Improvement Scheme Orders Revocation Order 1973, and shall come into operation on 25th April 1973.

Revocation of previous orders

2. The St. James's and The Green Parks Regulations (Temporary Amendment) Order 1961(c) and the Hyde Park Regulations (Second Temporary Amendment) Order 1961(d) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the order.)

This order revokes the St. James's and The Green Parks Regulations (Temporary Amendment) Order 1961 and the Hyde Park Regulations (Second Temporary Amendment) Order 1961 which allowed commercial traffic to use certain specified roads in the Parks, and hackney carriages to solicit passengers on them, during the carrying out of the Park Lane Improvement Scheme. The Hyde Park Regulations (Second Temporary Amendment) Order 1961 itself revoked and superseded the Hyde Park (Temporary Amendment) Regulations 1960. (S.I. 1960/1233).
