The Consular Fees (Amendment) Order 1973

Made - - - - 29th March 1973

Coming into Operation 25th April 1973

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 29th day of March 1973

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 2(1) of the Consular Salaries and Fees Act 1891(a) and section 8(1) of the Fees (Increase) Act 1923(b), or otherwise in Her Majesty vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order shall come into operation on 25th April 1973 and may be cited as the Consular Fees (Amendment) Order 1973.

2. Part I of the table of consular fees in the Schedule annexed to the Consular Fees Order 1971(c) as amended(d) is hereby amended by inserting after sub-paragraph (b) of Fee 6 the following sub-paragraph:—

“(c) by photographic process, copies of treaty texts, £
for each page (with minimum charge of £0.50) ... 0.05”
