The Patents Etc. (Federal Republic of Germany and German Democratic Republic) (Convention) Order 1973

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 68(1) of the Patents Act 1949(a), section 13(1) of the Registered Designs Act 1949(b), and section 91A(1) of the Patents and Designs Act 1907(c), as amended(d) is pleased to declare, and it is hereby declared, as follows:-

- 1—(1) This Order may be cited as the Patents Etc. (Federal Republic of Germany and German Democratic Republic) (Convention) Order 1973, and shall come into operation on 21st May 1973.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(e) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if this Order and the Order herein mentioned were Acts of Parliament.
- 2. The Federal Republic of Germany (and Berlin (West)) and the German Democratic Republic (and Berlin (East)) are Convention countries for all the purposes of the said Acts.
- 3. The Patents Etc. (Convention Countries) (No. 1) Order 1938(f) shall have effect as if there were omitted therefrom the reference to Germany.
