# The Jurors' Allowances (Amendment) Regulations 1973

Made - - - 30th May 1973 Coming into Operation 2nd July 1973

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 1 of the Juries Act 1949(a), as amended by section 1 of the Juries Act 1954(b), section 36 of the Courts Act 1971(c) and section 27 of the Criminal Justice Act 1972(d), and with the consent of the Minister for the Civil Service, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Jurors' Allowances (Amendment) Regulations 1973 and shall come into operation on 2nd July 1973.
- 2. Regulation 5 of the Jurors' Allowances Regulations 1972(e) shall be amended as follows:—
  - (a) in paragraph (2)(a), for the words "the sum of £2·37½" there shall be substituted the words "the sum of £2·75;"
  - (b) in paragraph (2)(b), for the words "the sum of £4.75" there shall be substituted the words "the sum of £5.50;"
  - (c) in paragraph (3), for the expression "£9.50" there shall be substituted the expression "£11".
