# MINES AND QUARRIES

# The Coal and Other Mines (Support) (Amendment) Regulations 1974

Made - - - 21st June 1974

Laid before Parliament 4th July 1974

Coming into Operation 1st October 1974

Whereas in pursuance of Part I of Schedule 2 to the Mines and Quarries Act 1954(a) the Secretary of State has published notice of his intention to make the following regulations and has not received any objection to the draft thereof in respect to which he is required to refer the draft regulations for inquiry and report:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 49, 54, 141 and 143 of the Mines and Quarries Act 1954 and now vested in him(b) and of all other powers in that behalf enabling him, hereby makes the following regulations:—

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Coal and Other Mines (Support) (Amendment) Regulations 1974 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1974.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The Coal and Other Mines (Support) Regulations 1966(d) shall have effect subject to the following modifications:—
  - (1) After regulation 5 the following regulation shall be inserted—
    - "5A—(1) The provisions of these regulations specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to these regulations shall have effect in relation to any working or part of a working in relation to which this regulation applies as if there were substituted for the measurements specified in Column 2 of the Schedule the measurements specified in Column 3 of the Schedule.
      - (2) This regulation applies in relation to:—
        - (a) any working begun in a mine on or after 1st October 1974;
        - (b) any other working or part of any other working in a mine which the manager of the mine by notice given to the inspector for the district elects to be a working or part of a working, as the case may be, in relation to which this regulation applies.
    - (3) A notice under paragraph (2)(b) of this regulation shall be of no effect unless it clearly and accurately describes the working or part of a working to which it refers."

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations modify the Coal and Other Mines (Support) Regulations 1966 by substituting, in relation to any working begun in a mine of coal, shale or fireclay on or after 1st October 1974 and any other working or part of a working in such a mine in respect of which the manager of the mine has given notice to the inspector for the district, for measurements expressed in imperial units measurements expressed in metric units.
