**The Regional Employment Premium (Continuation of Payment)
(Winsford) (Amendment) Order 1974**

Laid before Parliament in draft

Made *23rd July 1974*

Coming into Operation *8th September 1974*

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 26(5)(b) of the Finance Act 1967(a), as amended by section 7(1)(c) of the Local Employment Act 1970(b) and by section 122(3)(b) of, and paragraph 7 of Schedule 27 to, the Finance Act 1972(c), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Regional Employment Premium (Continuation of Payment) (Winsford) (Amendment) Order 1974, and shall come into operation on 8th September 1974.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The Regional Employment Premium (Continuation of Payment) Order 1972(e) shall be amended, in article 3(1) thereof, as follows:—

(a) for the words “increases of the whole” there shall be substituted the word “payments”;

(b) for the word “paid”, where it secondly occurs, there shall be substituted the word “made”; and

(c) for the words “8th September 1974” there shall be substituted the words “7th September 1975”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Regional Employment Premium (Continuation of Payment) Order 1972 which provided for payment of regional employment premiums in respect of registered establishments in Winsford Urban District to continue until 8th September 1974.

This Order extends until 7th September 1975 the period during which the premiums are to continue to be so paid. The Order also makes some minor amendments consequent on the amendment of section 26 of the Finance Act 1967 by Schedule 27 to the Finance Act 1972.
