The Independent Schools Tribunal (Amendment No. 2)

Rules 1974

Made - - - - 19th September 1974

Coming into Operation 22nd October 1974

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 75(1) of the Education Act 1944(a) and with the concurrence of the Lord President of the Council and the consent of the Minister for the Civil Service, in exercise of the powers now vested in him(b), hereby makes the following Rules:—

1.—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Independent Schools Tribunal (Amendment No. 2) Rules 1974 and shall come into operation on 22nd October 1974.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of these Rules as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. Paragraph (2) of the Second Schedule to the Independent Schools Tribunal Rules 1958(d), as amended(e), shall be further amended as follows:—

(a) in sub-paragraph (a), for the figures “£0·48” and “£1·05” there shall be substituted the figures “£0·66” and “£1·45” respectively;

(b) in sub-paragraph (b), for the figures “£6·86” and “£6·24” there shall be substituted the figures “£9·50” and “£8·65” respectively.
