The Collision Regulations (Traffic Separation Schemes) (Amendment) Order 1974

14th November 1974 Made -20th November 1974 Laid before Parliament Coming into Operation 12th December 1974

At the Court at Buckingham Palace the 14th day of November 1974 Present.

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by sections 418 and 738 of the Merchant Shipping Act 1894(a) and all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, on the joint recommendation of the Secretary of State for Defence(b) and the Secretary of State for Trade(c), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Collision Regulations (Traffic Separation Schemes) (Amendment) Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 12th December 1974.
- 2. The Collision Regulations (Traffic Separation Schemes) Order 1972(d) shall have effect as though in Part II of the Schedule (traffic separation schemes to which the Regulations apply) the following traffic separation schemes were deleted:
 - (a) in section B (Western European waters), paragraph 26 (Newarp/Cross Sand); and
 - (b) in section D (Indian Ocean and adjacent waters)—
 - (i) paragraph 1 (off Cape Agulhas—Quoin Point—Slangkop Point);
 - (ii) paragraph 2 (off Slangkop Point).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order in Council amends the Collision Regulations (Traffic Separation Schemes) Order 1972 (which sets out traffic separation schemes for ships) by deleting certain traffic separation schemes set out in the Schedule to that Order. The deletions comprise one scheme in Western European waters (Newarp/Cross Sand) and two schemes in the Indian Ocean and adjacent waters (off Cape Agulhas—Quoin Point—Slangkop Point; and off Slangkop Point).
