The Merchant Shipping Act 1970 (Commencement No. 3)

Order 1974

Made - - - - 15th November 1974

Coming into Operation 18th November 1974

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 101(4) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1970(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and now vested in him (b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Merchant Shipping Act 1970 (Commencement No. 3) Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 18th November 1974.

2. The provisions of the Act specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order (which relate to the matters specified in the second column of that Schedule) shall come into operation on 18th November 1974.
