# The Police (Grant) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1974

Made - - - 19th December 1974

Laid before Parliament 7th January 1975

Coming into Operation 1st April 1975

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 31 of the Police Act 1964(a), I hereby, with the approval of the Treasury, make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Police (Grant) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1974 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1975.
- 2. In this Order "the principal Order" means the Police (Grant) Order 1966(b), as amended (c).
- 3. Sub-paragraph (c) of Article 4(1) of the principal Order (metropolitan police district) is hereby revoked.
- **4.** In paragraph 3 of Schedule 1 to the principal Order (payment of police grant) for the proportion "95 per cent" there shall be substituted the proportion " $97\frac{1}{2}$  per cent".

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Under the Police (Grant) Order 1966 payments on account of police grant made during the year to which the grant relates may not exceed 95 per cent, or in the case of grant payable to the Receiver for the Metropolitan Police District 97½ per cent, of the estimated grant for the year.

This Order amends the Order of 1966 to provide, with effect from 1st April 1975, that the limit on such payments shall in all cases be  $97\frac{1}{2}$  per cent.
