**The Felixstowe—Weedon Trunk Road
(Ipswich—Felixstowe Trunking) Order 1974**

Made 14th February 1974

Coming into Operation 5th April 1974

The Secretary of State for the Environment makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by section 7 of the Highways Act 1959(a), and now vested in him (b), and of all other enabling powers:—

1. The highway described in The Schedule to this Order shall become a trunk road as from the date when this Order comes into operation.

2. In this Order:—

“the deposited plan”

means the plan folio numbered HA7/2-E85, marked “The Felixstowe—Weedon Trunk Road (Ipswich—Felixstowe Trunking) Order 1974” signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Department of the Environment, St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London SE1 0TE, where it may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours.

3. This Order shall come into operation on 5th April 1974 and may be cited as the Felixstowe—Weedon Trunk Road (Ipswich—Felixstowe Trunking) Order 1974.
