

1974 No. 266 (S.15)**NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE, SCOTLAND****The National Health Service (Determination of Areas of Health Boards) (Scotland) Order 1974***Made - - - - 18th February 1974**Laid before Parliament 6th March 1974**Coming into Operation 18th March 1974*

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 13(1) and 62(6) of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1972(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consultation with such bodies and organisations as appear to me to be concerned, I hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the National Health Service (Determination of Areas of Health Boards) (Scotland) Order 1974, and shall come into operation on 18th March 1974.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3.—(1) Each of the areas described in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule to this order shall be an area for which a Health Board is to be constituted, but column 3 shall cease to have effect on and after 16th May 1975.

(2) Each Health Board area shall be known by the title set out in column 1 of the Schedule opposite the description of that area.

4. The National Health Service (Determination of Areas of Health Boards) (Scotland) Order 1973(c) is hereby revoked.

It revokes the National Health Service (Determination of Areas of Health Boards) (Scotland) Order 1973 by which the areas were previously defined.
