At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 29th day of May 1974

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 27(6) of the Northern Ireland Constitution Act 1973 (a), and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Northern Ireland Assembly (Prorogation) Order 1974 and shall come into operation forthwith.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889 (b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The Northern Ireland Assembly is hereby prorogued for a period of four months commencing with the day on which this Order is made.
