**The Pensions Increase (Presidents and Chairmen
of Industrial Tribunals) Regulations 1974**

The Minister for the Civil Service, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 5(2) and (4) of the Pensions (Increase) Act 1971(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Pensions Increase (Presidents and Chairmen of Industrial Tribunals) Regulations 1974, and shall come into operation on 10th July 1974.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The Pensions (Increase) Act 1971 shall have effect in relation to a pension payable under section 9 of the Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1967(c) (whole-time presidents or chairmen of industrial tribunals) as if it were specified in Part I of Schedule 2 to the Pensions (Increase) Act 1971.

4. Any increase of pension payable by virtue of these Regulations shall take effect from 1st December 1973.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations provide for the payment of increases under the Pensions (Increase) Act 1971 on pensions of whole-time presidents and chairmen of industrial tribunals.

Under the powers in section 5(4) of the 1971 Act the Regulations provide for the increases to take effect from 1st December 1973.
