The Police Grant (Scotland) Order 1975

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 32 of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967 (a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby, with the approval of the Treasury, make the following order:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Police Grant (Scotland) Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 15th August 1975.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889 (b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. In paragraph 3 of the Schedule to the Police Grant (Scotland) Order 1947 (c), as amended (d), for the words and figures “95 per cent” there shall be substituted the words and figures “97½ per cent”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Police Grant (Scotland) Order 1947 to provide that payments on account of police grant during the year to which the grant relates shall not exceed $97\frac{1}{2}$ per cent of the estimate of the grant for that year (instead of 95 per cent).
