The Severn Bridge (Amendment) Regulations 1975

<i>Coming into Operation</i>		1st September 1975

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 7(5) of the Severn Bridge Tolls Act 1965(a), and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Severn Bridge (Amendment) Regulations 1975, and shall come into operation on 1st September 1975.

2. The Severn Bridge Regulations 1966(c), as amended(d), shall be further amended by substituting in paragraph (6) of Regulation 12 (which relates to charges for the removal of vehicles) for the words “£5 for the first hour or part of an hour taken and £1 for each quarter of an hour or part of a quarter of an hour taken after the first hour” the words “£8 for the first half hour or part of an half hour taken and £2 for each quarter of an hour or part of a quarter of an hour taken after the first half hour”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations increase the charges to be paid under Regulation 12 of the Severn Bridge Regulations 1966 for the removal, repair or adjustment of a broken down vehicle from £5 for the first hour or part thereof to £8 for the first half hour or part thereof and from £1 for each quarter hour or part thereof taken after the first hour to £2 for each quarter hour or part thereof taken after the first half hour.
