The Anti-Dumping Duty (Temporary Suspension) (No. 5) **Order 1975**

27th October 1975 Made -

Laid before the House of Commons 3rd November 1975

Coming into Operation -24th November 1975

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 1, 10(3) and 15(4) of the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1969(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Anti-Dumping Duty (Temporary Suspension) (No. 5) Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 24th November
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The anti-dumping duty imposed by the Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties Order 1973(d) on unwrought magnesium originating in the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics shall not be chargeable on unwrought magnesium imported into the United Kingdom during a period of twelve months beginning with the date of coming into operation of this Order.
