PROBATION AND AFTER-CARE

The Probation (Allowances) (Amendment) Rules 1975

Made - - - - 10th April 1975 Laid before Parliament 18th April 1975 Coming into Operation 12th May 1975

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Schedule 3 to the Powers of Criminal Courts Act 1973(a), I hereby make the following Rules:—

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Probation (Allowances) (Amendment) Rules 1975 and shall come into operation on 12th May 1975.
- 2. The Probation (Allowances) Rules 1971(b), as amended(c), shall be amended as follows:—
 - (a) in paragraph 3(1) of Schedule 1 for the words "1·3p", "1·7p" and "1·9p" there shall be substituted the words "1·7p", "2·1p" and "2·6p" respectively;
 - (b) in paragraph 3(2) of Schedule 1 for the words "2.5p", "2.8p", "6.4p", "6.9p" and "7.8p" there shall be substituted the words "3p", "3.5p", "7.1p", "7.9p" and "9p" respectively;
 - (c) in paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 1 for the words "2.5p" in each case where they occur there shall be substituted the words "3p" and for the words "3.5p" there shall be substituted the words "4p"; and
 - (d) in paragraph 1 of Schedule 2 for the words "£1·35", "£2·40", "£3·40", "£4·05", "£8·65" and "80p" there shall be substituted the words "£1·65", "£2·90", "£4·10", "£4·90", "£10·40" and "£1·00" respectively.
