**The Companies (Fees) Regulations 1975**

*Laid before Parliament in draft*

*Made - - - - - 10th April 1975*

*Coming into Operation 2nd June 1975*

Whereas a draft of these regulations has been laid before Parliament and approved by resolution of each House pursuant to section 48(3) of the Companies Act 1967(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"):

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 48(2) of the Act and now vested in him (b), hereby makes the following regulations:

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Companies (Fees) Regulations 1975 and shall come into operation on 2nd June 1975.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) The Companies (Fees) Regulations 1973(d) are hereby revoked.

2. For Schedule 3 to the Act there shall be substituted the Schedule to these regulations.

## FEES TO BE PAID TO THE REGISTRAR OF COMPANIES

For registration of a company on its formation under the Companies Act 1948(a), re-registration of a company under that Act in pursuance of section 44 of the Companies Act 1967 or registration of a company under the Companies Act 1948 in pursuance of Part VIII thereof as a limited company (not being a company in whose case the liability of the members thereof was, before registration in pursuance of that Part, limited by some other Act or by letters patent) ... ..	50
For re-registration of a company under the Companies Act 1948 in pursuance of section 43 of the Companies Act 1967 ... ..	5
For registration of a copy of an annual return or copies of documents delivered to the registrar of companies in compliance with section 410 of the Companies Act 1948 ... ..	20
For entering on the register the name of a company assumed by virtue of the passing of a special resolution by virtue of section 18(1) of the Companies Act 1948 ... ..	40

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the regulations.)*

These regulations supersede the Companies (Fees) Regulations 1973.

The fee payable to the registrar of companies for the registration of—

(a) a copy of an annual return, and

(b) copies of accounts delivered to the registrar of companies by overseas companies in compliance with section 410 of the Companies Act 1948 is increased in each case from £3 to £20.

In other respects the fees payable to the registrar of companies are unchanged.
