The Milk Distributive Wages Council (Scotland) (Abolition) Order 1976

Made - - 28th July 1976

Laid before Parliament 6th August 1976

Coming into Operation 6th September 1976

Whereas the Secretary of State in accordance with section 4 of, and Schedule 1 to, the Wages Councils Act 1959(a) published notice of his intention to make an order abolishing the Milk Distributive Wages Council (Scotland):

And whereas no objection has been made with respect to the draft order referred to in the said notice:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred by section 4(1)(a) of the said Act of 1959, and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1. The Milk Distributive Wages Council (Scotland) is hereby abolished.
- 2.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Milk Distributive Wages Council (Scotland) (Abolition) Order 1976, and shall come into operation on 6th September 1976.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order abolishes the Milk Distributive Wages Council (Scotland) which was established as a Trade Board under the Trade Boards Act 1909 (c.22). The Trade Board was converted into a Wages Council by the Wages Councils Act 1945 (c.17) and was continued in existence as such by the Wages Councils Act 1959 (c.69).
