## INJURIES IN WAR COMPENSATION

# The Injuries in War (Shore Employments) Compensation (Amendment) Scheme 1976

Made - - - 6th September 1976

The Defence Council, with the consent of the Minister for the Civil Service, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 1 of the Injuries in War Compensation Act 1914 (Session 2)(a) (as amended by the Defence (Transfer of Functions) (No. 1) Order 1964 (b)) and section 1(1) and (3) of the Defence (Transfer of Functions) Act 1964(c) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Scheme:—

1. The Injuries in War (Shore Employments) Compensation Scheme 1914 as amended(d) shall be further amended as follows:

In paragraph (3) thereof for the figures "£21·80", wherever they occur, there shall be substituted the figures "£25·00".

- 2. This Scheme shall have effect as from 15th November 1976, so, however, that no payment shall be made thereunder in respect of any period before that date.
- 3. This Scheme may be cited as the Injuries in War (Shore Employments) Compensation (Amendment) Scheme 1976 and the Injuries in War (Shore Employments) Compensation Schemes 1914 to 1975 and this Scheme may be cited together as the Injuries in War (Shore Employments) Compensation Schemes 1914 to 1976.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Scheme.)

The Injuries in War (Shore Employments) Compensation Schemes 1914 to 1975 provide for the payment of weekly allowance to small numbers of exmembers of the Women's Auxiliary Forces who suffered disablement from their services overseas during the 1914-18 war. This amending Scheme provides that the maximum weekly allowance payable shall be increased from £21.80 to £25 and that other allowances shall be increased proportionately. The increases will take effect as from 15th November 1976 in accordance with section 1(5) of the Injuries in War Compensation Act, 1914 (Session 2).
