CIVIL AVIATION

The Civil Aviation Act 1971 (Commencement No. 5) Order 1976

Made - - - - - 28th September 1976

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 70(2) of the Civil Aviation Act 1971(a), hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Civil Aviation Act (Commencement No. 5) Order 1976.

2. The provisions of Schedule 11 to the Civil Aviation Act 1971, in so far as they are not already in force, shall come into force on 26th October 1976.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The Civil Aviation Act 1971 (Commencement No. 4) Order 1972 brought into force on 1st April 1972, with one minor exception, those provisions of the Civil Aviation Act 1971 which had not already been brought into force. This Order brings into force on 26th October 1976 this excepted provision, namely Schedule 11 to the Civil Aviation Act 1971 so far as it repeals section 8(6) of the Air Corporations Act 1967 (c. 33). The exception was a transitional provision and preserved the duties of the Secretary of State and the Comptroller and Auditor General in relation to sums advanced to BOAC and BEA before 1st April 1972.
