The Import Duties (Temporary Reductions and Exemptions) (No. 25) Order 1976

Made	1st December 1976
Laid before the House of Commons	9th December 1976
Coming into Operation	1st January 1977

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, by virtue of the powers conferred on them by sections 1, 2, 3(6) and 13 of the Import Duties Act 1958(a), as amended by section 5(5) of, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 4 to, the European Communities Act 1972(b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, on the recommendation of the Secretary of State(c), hereby make the following Order:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Import Duties (Temporary Reductions and Exemptions) (No. 25) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1977.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. The Import Duties (Temporary Reductions and Exemptions) (No. 23) Order 1975(e) shall be amended as follows:
 - (a) for "31st December 1976" wherever occurring there shall be substituted "30th June 1977";
 - (b) in Article 7(1)(c) after "de-icing systems and parts" there shall be inserted "and parts of transistorised voltage regulators,";
 - (c) in Part I of Schedules 1 and 2, in column 2 of heading 39.07 for "silicon" there shall be substituted "silicones";
 - (d) in Part II of Schedules 1 and 2 there shall be deleted from column 3 the word "Concorde" in relation to the following entry:

 - terrestrial magnetic-field detector apparatus, by saturation of magnetic circuits (flux valve);

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order, which comes into operation on 1st January 1977, amends the Import Duties (Temporary Reductions and Exemptions) (No. 23) Order 1975 (the principal Order), by continuing up to and including 30th June 1977 with one exception the exemptions from or reductions in duty in the case of goods specified in that Order. The exception is that in Part II of Schedules 1 and 2 of the principal Order the exemption from import duty on certain terrestrial magnetic-field detector apparatus imported for the construction, maintenance or repair of Concorde is no longer continued.

This Order also amends Schedule 4 of the principal Order by providing for exemption from import duty on certain additional goods falling within headings 90.14 and 90.29.

Goods specified in the Schedules to the principal Order as amended by this Order are subject to total or partial suspension of duty in the Common Customs Tariff of the European Economic Community and the amendments in this Order are made in accordance with the United Kingdom's Community obligations.
