**The Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) (Amendment)
(No. 2) Regulations 1976**

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 23 (as modified by section 39(1) and paragraph 20 of Part I of Schedule 7) and 37 of the Vehicles (Excise) Act 1971(a) and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st January 1977 and may be cited as the Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1976.

2. The Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) Regulations 1971(b), as amended(c), shall be further amended so as to have effect as if in Regulation 9 (Assignment of registration marks)—

- (a) in paragraph (3) after the words “The registration mark assigned to a vehicle shall”, and in paragraph (4) after the words “shall be the registration mark of the vehicle and shall”, there were inserted in each place the words—
- “, save where the mark is assigned to another vehicle, or another mark is assigned to the vehicle, by the Secretary of State,”; and
- (b) in the said paragraph (4) the words from “Provided that” to the end were deleted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) Regulations 1971, so that the Secretary of State may transfer the registration mark assigned to a vehicle to another vehicle, or assigned to a vehicle another registration mark.

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
