**The Local Education Authorities Recoupment
(Further Education) (Amendment) Regulations 1976**

The Secretary of State for Education and Science, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 7(4) of the Education (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1953(a) and vested in him(b), hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Local Education Authorities Recoupment (Further Education) (Amendment) Regulations 1976 and shall come into operation on 7th April 1976.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Amendment of 1954 Regulations

2. At the end of regulation 4(6) of the Local Education Authorities Recoupment (Further Education) Regulations 1954(d) as amended by regulation 2 of the Local Education Authorities Recoupment (Further Education) (Amendment) Regulations 1975(e) (exceptions to rule for determining the area to which a pupil is treated as belonging), there shall be added—

“In this paragraph “award” does not include an award under section 2(1) of the Education Act 1962(f) in pursuance of which the only payments falling to be made by the authority are in respect of the student’s travelling expenses.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the provisions made by the Local Education Authorities Recoupment (Further Education) Regulations 1954 as amended that a person upon whom a local education authority have bestowed an award in respect of his attendance at a course of full-time education shall be treated for recoupment purposes as belonging to the area of that authority while he attends the course. The regulations exclude from the operation of that provision a student upon whom an award has been bestowed under section 2(1) of the Education Act 1962 under which the only payments made to him relate to his travelling expenses in attending the course.
