The Cambridge Water Order 1976

Made -17th March 1976 22nd March 1976 Coming into Operation

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 33 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:-

1.--(1) This order may be cited as the Cambridge Water Order 1976 Citation and shall come into operation on 22nd March 1976.

(2) The Cambridge Water Acts and Orders 1853 to 1975 and this order may be cited together as the Cambridge Water Acts and Orders 1853 to 1976.

2. In this order—

"the Company" means the Cambridge Water Company;

"the undertaking" means the undertaking of the Company as for the time being authorised by any enactment.

3. Subsection (1) of section 26 (As to directors) of the Cambridge Cambridge University and Town Waterworks Act 1934(c) shall have effect as if for the word "eight" there were substituted the word "nine".

4. For the purposes of this order, section 94 of the Third Schedule to Application the Water Act 1945 (which requires undertakers to keep a copy of the of section 94 of Third special Act at their principal office and to deposit copies with certain Schedule to officers) shall apply to the undertaking and is hereby incorporated with Water Act this order. 1945.

5. The costs, charges and expenses of and incidental to the application Costs of for and the preparation and making of this order may in whole or in order. part be defrayed out of revenue.
