**The Coal Industry (Redundancy Payments Schemes)
(Extension) Order 1976**
*Laid before the House of Commons in draft**Made - - - - - 25th March 1976**Coming into Operation 26th March 1976*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 3(1) of the Coal Industry Act 1967(a) as amended by section 2(1) of the Coal Industry Act 1971(b) and section 4(a) of the Coal Industry Act 1973(c) and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order, a draft of which has been laid before the Commons House of Parliament and approved by a resolution of that House in accordance with section 3(4A) of the Coal Industry Act 1967, added by section 4(c) of the Coal Industry Act 1973:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Coal Industry (Redundancy Payments Schemes) (Extension) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 26th March 1976.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The power bestowed by section 3(1) of the Coal Industry Act 1967, as so amended, to make schemes providing for payments to or in respect of redundant workers in the coal industry and in respect of arrangements relating to concessionary coal shall have effect in relation to persons becoming redundant between 17th July 1967 and 26th March 1978.

 EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Under section 3(1) of the Coal Industry Act 1967, as amended, the Secretary of State may make schemes providing for payments to or in respect of workers in the coal industry who are made redundant between 17th July 1967 and 28th March 1976, and has power to extend this period by Order to 26th March 1978. This Order extends that period accordingly.
