EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into force all the provisions of the Criminal Jurisdiction Act 1975, except so far as they are already in force. The provisions brought into force by the Order include provisions creating criminal liability under the law of Northern Ireland for certain offences committed in the Republic of Ireland and those relating to the procedure for the trial of such offences and of corresponding offences under the law of the Republic; and provisions amending the Explosive Substances Act 1883 (c.3).
