The Scottish Land Court (Fees) Amendment Rules 1976

Made - - - - - 20th January 1976

Coming into operation 18th February 1976

The Scottish Land Court in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 3(12) of the Small Landholders (Scotland) Act 1911 (a) and all other powers enabling them in that behalf with the approval of the Treasury hereby make the following rules:—

1. For the Table of Fees contained in Schedule 3 to the Rules of the Scottish Land Court (b) as amended (c) there shall be substituted the Table set out in the Schedule hereto.
2. These rules may be cited as the Scottish Land Court (Fees) Amendment Rules 1976 and shall come into operation on 18th February 1976.
