## The Trunk Road (Malden Way, Kingston-Upon-Thames) (Restricted Road) Order 1977

Made	-		30th June 1977
Coming	into	Operation	4th July 1977

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the powers conferred by section 72(3) and 73(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 (a) as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 (b), and now vested in him (c), and of all other enabling powers, hereby orders and directs as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trunk Road (Malden Way, Kingstonupon-Thames) (Restricted Road) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 4th July 1977.

2.—(1) In this Order:—

"Malden Roundabout" means the roundabout at the junction of Malden Way with Malden Road.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889 (d) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in Malden Roundabout.
