The Anglian Water Authority (Whittlesey Internal Drainage District) Order 1977

Coming into Operation				21st June 1977

Whereas before 17th January 1977 the Anglian Water Authority prepared and submitted to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (hereinafter called "the Minister") for confirmation a Scheme (hereinafter called "the Scheme") under section 4(1)(b) of the Land Drainage Act 1930(a), as amended and applied by the Water Act 1973(b), in relation to the Whittlesey Internal Drainage District;

And whereas, by virtue of section 117(1) of, and paragraph 6 of Schedule 6 to, the Land Drainage Act 1976(c) (which Act came into force on 17th January 1977), as from 17th January 1977 the Scheme is treated as having been prepared and submitted to the Minister for confirmation under section 11(1) of the Land Drainage Act 1976;

And whereas the Minister has decided to confirm the Scheme subject to the modifications set out in Article 3 of this Order;

And whereas a copy of the Scheme with the said modifications incorporated therein is annexed hereto;

Now, therefore, the Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 11(4) and 109(6) of the Land Drainage Act 1976 and of every other power enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order, which may be cited as the Anglian Water Authority (Whittlesey Internal Drainage District) Order 1977, shall, unless subject to special parliamentary procedure, come into operation on the date of its confirmation by the Minister.

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The Scheme is hereby confirmed subject to the following modifications:-

(1) in the heading, immediately below "Water Act 1973" there shall be inserted the words "Land Drainage Act 1976"; and

(2) in paragraph 3, for the words from "section 33" to the end of the first sentence of that paragraph there shall be substituted the following words:--

"section 7 of, and Schedule 2 to, the Land Drainage Act 1976".

4. The expenses of the Minister in connection with the making and confirmation of this Order shall be borne by the Anglian Water Authority and shall be part of the administrative expenses of that Authority.

ANGLIAN WATER AUTHORITY

WHITTLESEY INTERNAL DRAINAGE DISTRICT

The ANGLIAN WATER AUTHORITY (hereinafter referred to as "the Water Authority") pursuant to section 4(1)(b) of the Land Drainage Act 1930, as amended and applied by the Water Act 1973, hereby make the following Scheme providing for certain matters referred to in the said section, namely:—

- (a) the abolition of the Whittlesey and Farcet Internal Drainage Board, the Whittlesey and Kingsland Internal Drainage Board and the Glassmoor and Mereside Internal Drainage Board;
- (b) the amalgamation of the drainage districts under the jurisdiction of the abovementioned Internal Drainage Boards into one new internal drainage district;
- (c) the constitution of a new internal drainage board for the internal drainage district formed by such amalgamation;
- (d) matters supplemental thereto or consequential thereon;

AND the Water Authority submit the Scheme to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food for confirmation under section 4(3) of the Land Drainage Act 1930.

SCHEME

- 1. In this Scheme, unless the context otherwise requires—
 - "the Minister" means the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food;
 - "the Appointed Day" means a day to be appointed by the Minister for the coming into operation of this Scheme;
 - "the Whittlesey and Farcet Internal Drainage Board" means the internal drainage board constituted by the Scheme confirmed by the River Great Ouse Catchment Board (Whittlesey and Farcet Internal Drainage District) Order 1937(a) and "the Whittlesey and Farcet Internal Drainage District" means the internal drainage district of that name as constituted by that Scheme;
 - "the Whittlesey and Kingsland Internal Drainage Board" means the internal drainage board constituted by the Scheme confirmed by the River Great Ouse Catchment Board (Whittlesey and Kingsland Internal Drainage District) Order 1947(b) and "the Whittlesey and Kingsland Internal Drainage District" means the internal drainage district of that name as constituted by that Scheme as altered by the Scheme confirmed by the River Great Ouse Catchment Board (Feldale and Whittlesey and Kingsland Internal Drainage Districts) Order 1950(c) and as further altered by the Scheme confirmed by the Great Ouse River Authority (Alteration of Boundaries of the Whittlesey and Kingsland Internal Drainage District) Order 1973(d);

- "the Glassmoor and Mereside Internal Drainage Board" means the internal drainage board constituted by the Scheme confirmed by the River Great Ouse Catchment Board (Glassmoor and Mereside Internal Drainage District) Order 1937(a) and
- "the Glassmoor and Mereside Internal Drainage District" means the internal drainage district of that name as constituted by that Scheme.
- 2. On the Appointed Day:—
 - (i) the Whittlesey and Farcet Internal Drainage Board, the Whittlesey and Kingsland Internal Drainage Board and the Glassmoor and Mereside Internal Drainage Board (hereinafter referred to collectively as "the Abolished Boards") shall be abolished;
 - (ii) the Whittlesey and Farcet Internal Drainage District, the Whittlesey and Kingsland Internal Drainage District and the Glassmoor and Mereside Internal Drainage District shall be amalgamated into, and shall constitute, one internal drainage district which shall be known as "the Whittlesey Internal Drainage District" (hereinafter referred to as "the Internal Drainage District");
 - (iii) there shall be constituted for the Internal Drainage District an internal drainage board to be known as "the Whittlesey Internal Drainage Board" (hereinafter referred to as "the Internal Drainage Board").

3. The Internal Drainage Board shall consist of nineteen members who, with the exception of the first members, shall be elected in accordance with the provisions of section 7 of, and Schedule 2 to, the Land Drainage Act 1976. The first members of the Internal Drainage Board shall be persons appointed by the Minister and shall hold office until the expiration of one year, from the first day of November next following the day on which they are appointed.

4. On the Appointed Day there shall be transferred to and be vested in or fall to be discharged by the Internal Drainage Board all such rights, powers, duties, obligations, liabilities and property (including in particular, but without prejudice to the generality of that expression, books of account, other books, deeds, maps, papers and other documents) as were immediately before the Appointed Day vested in or to be discharged by the Abolished Boards or any of them respectively including (but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing) all property, rights, powers, duties, obligations and liabilities vested in or to be discharged by them under or by virtue of any local Act or Order made under statutory authority.

5. All arrears of rates made before the Appointed Day in respect of any land within the Internal Drainage District by the Abolished Boards or any of them in respect of any period or periods, ending before the Appointed Day, may be recovered by the Internal Drainage Board in the same manner as if they had been rates made by the Internal Drainage Board.

6. All property and liabilities transferred to the Internal Drainage Board under paragraph 4 of this Scheme in respect of which immediately before such transfer some part only of the Internal Drainage District was entitled to receive the benefit or was liable shall, as to any income arising therefrom or any expenditure in relation thereto (whether of a capital or of a revenue nature) be applied to the benefit of, or as the case may be, be a charge upon the rates levied only upon, that part of the Internal Drainage District:

Provided that the Internal Drainage Board may, subject to the approval of the Water Authority, apply the value of the property and charge the liabilities transferred under this Scheme to or upon the whole of the Internal Drainage District or such part or parts thereof and in such manner as they from time to time shall think fair.

7. As respects any matter transferred under this Scheme the Scheme shall operate as conclusive evidence of the transfer without the necessity of any further assignment, deed of transfer or conveyance. 8. The accounts of each of the Abolished Boards shall be made up to the Appointed Day and copies thereof forthwith sent to the Internal Drainage Board and such accounts shall be audited in like manner and be subject to the like incidents and consequences as if this Scheme had not been confirmed by the Anglian Water Authority (Whittlesey Internal Drainage District) Order 1977.

9. Copies of the minutes of each meeting of the Internal Drainage Board shall be delivered to the Water Authority within 28 days after such meeting.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order, made by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, confirms, with modifications, a Scheme submitted to him by the Anglian Water Authority for the abolition of the Whittlesey and Farcet Internal Drainage Board, the Whittlesey and Kingsland Internal Drainage Board, and the Glassmoor and Mereside Internal Drainage Board, and for the amalgamation of the internal drainage districts thereof into, and the constitution of, one internal drainage district to be known as the Whittlesey Internal Drainage District. The Scheme provides also for the constitution of an internal drainage board for the new internal drainage district to be known as the Whittlesey Internal Drainage Board, and makes provision for the appointment of first members of the Board.

Maps of the three internal drainage districts amalgamated by virtue of the Scheme are available for inspection during office hours at the offices of the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, Great Westminster House, Horseferry Road, London SW1P 2AE, and certified copies thereof may be inspected during office hours at the offices of the Anglian Water Authority, Great Ouse House, Clarendon Road, Cambridge CB2 2BL, and at the offices of the Whittlesey Internal Drainage Board.
