# The Bread Prices (No. 2) Order 1976 (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 1977

Made	14th July 1977
Laid before Parliament	15th July 1977
Coming into Operation	18th July 1977

The Secretary of State, after consulting in accordance with subsection (6) of section 2 of the Prices Act 1974(a) as amended(b) with the organisations therein referred to, in exercise of his powers under subsections (1) and (8) of that section and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Bread Prices (No. 2) Order 1976 (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 18th July 1977.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament, and as if this Order and the Order hereby revoked were Acts of Parliament.
- 2. Article 3 of the Bread Prices (No. 2) Order 1976(d) as varied (e) is hereby further varied by the substitution for Table 1 set out in that article of the following Table—
