# The Forest Reproductive Material (Amendment) **Regulations 1977**

Made	22nd July 1977
Laid before Parliament	8th August 1977
Coming into Operation	9th August 1977

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers vested in them by subsections (1), (1A), (2), (3), (4) and (8) of section 16 of the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act 1964(a) as amended by section 4(1) of, and sub-paragraphs (1), (2), (3), (4) and (5) of paragraph 5 of Schedule 4 to, the European Communities Act 1972(b), and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, after consultation with representatives of such interests as appear to them to be concerned, hereby make the following regulations:—

#### Citation and commencement

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Forest Reproductive Material (Amendment) Regulations 1977.
  - (2) These regulations shall come into operation on 9th August 1977.

#### **Interpretation**

- 2.—(1) In these regulations "the principal regulations" means the Forest Reproductive Material Regulations 1977(c).
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

#### Amendment of the principal regulations

3. The principal regulations shall be amended by the deletion of Part C of Schedule 2 to those regulations, and the substitution therefor of the following—

Items 3, 4, 5, 6 and 8 of Part A shall apply insofar as they are appropriate.".
