INSURANCE

The Insurance Brokers (Registration) Act 1977
(Commencement No. 1) Order 1977

Made - - - - 3rd November 1977

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 30(3) of the Insurance Brokers (Registration) Act 1977(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Insurance Brokers (Registration) Act 1977 (Commencement No. 1) Order 1977.

2. The following provisions of the Insurance Brokers (Registration) Act 1977 shall come into operation on 1st December 1977, that is to say—

- Section 1 (establishment of Council);
- Section 6 (approval of educational institutions and qualifications);
- Section 7 (supervision of educational institutions and qualifying examinations);
- Section 8 (supplementary provisions as to the register and list);
- Section 10 (code of conduct);
- Section 11 (requirements for carrying on business);
- Section 12 (professional indemnity, etc);
- Section 19(4) to (6) (rules of procedure and evidence for proceedings before Disciplinary Committee);
- Section 21 (general power to appoint committees);
- Section 25 (accounts of Council);
- Section 26 (service of documents);
- Section 27 (rules etc made by Council);
- Section 28 (orders);
- Section 29 (interpretation);
- Section 30 (short title, extent and commencement);
- Schedule (constitution, etc of Council).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into force on 1st December 1977 the provisions of the Insurance Brokers (Registration) Act 1977 that relate to the establishment and functions of the Insurance Brokers Registration Council and the doing of the necessary preparatory work for the establishment of the register of insurance brokers and list of bodies corporate carrying on business as such brokers.
