**The County Courts (Admiralty Jurisdiction)
(Amendment No. 2) Order 1977***Made* - - - - - 28th February 1977*Coming into Operation* 1st April 1977

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 55 of the County Courts Act 1959(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the County Courts (Admiralty Jurisdiction) (Amendment No. 2) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1977.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The County Courts (Admiralty Jurisdiction) Order 1971(c), as amended (d), shall have effect subject to the following further amendments to the Schedule thereto:—

- (a) in the entry relating to the Truro and Falmouth County Court, the words “and Falmouth” shall be deleted; and
- (b) the references to the Bideford, Dorchester, Kingsbridge and Minehead County Court Districts shall be deleted from column 2 of the Schedule.
