# The Companies (Winding-up) (Amendment) Rules 1977

Made -2nd March 1977 Laid before Parliament 11th March 1977 Coming into Operation 1st April 1977

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 365(1) of the Companies Act 1948(a), with the concurrence of the Secretary of State for Trade, and after consulting the committee appointed under section 10 of the Insolvency Act 1976(b), hereby makes the following Rules:-

- 1.—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Companies (Winding-up) (Amendment) Rules 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1977.
- (2) The amendments set out in these Rules shall be made to the Companies (Winding-up) Rules 1949(c), as amended (d), and to the Appendix thereto.
- 2. In rules 169, 196, 199 and 200 there shall be substituted for the words "the Companies Liquidation Account" the words "the Insolvency Services Account".
- 3. In the forms in the Appendix there shall be substituted for the words "the Companies Liquidation Account" wherever they appear the words "the Insolvency Services Account".

# **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules amend the Companies (Winding-up) Rules 1949 by replacing references to the Companies Liquidation Account with references to the Insolvency Services Account. This change is consequential upon section 3 of the Insolvency Act 1976, which comes into force on the same day as these Rules and replaces the Companies Liquidation Account and the Bankruptcy Estates Account with a single Insolvency Services Account. The forms referred to in rule 3 which are affected are those numbered 92, 97 and 110.
