# The Berkshire and Oxfordshire (Areas) (Amendment) Order 1977

Made - - - 4th March 1977

Laid before Parliament 10th March 1977

Coming into Operation 31st March 1977

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 51(2) of the Local Government Act 1972(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

- 1. This order may be cited as the Berkshire and Oxfordshire (Areas) (Amendment) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 31st March 1977.
- 2. In the Berkshire and Oxfordshire (Areas) Order 1977(b), in article 5, in paragraph (5) (electoral divisions in the County of Oxfordshire), for "formed by paragraph 4(b) and ward No. 26 of the said district." there shall be substituted "formed by paragraph (4)(b), ward No. 23 of the said district as altered by this order and ward No. 26 of the said district.".

# **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Article 5(5)(b) of the Berkshire and Oxfordshire (Areas) Order 1977 formed, as from 9th May 1977, a new Henley Rural No. 1A electoral division in the County of Oxfordshire. The statement of the extent of the division omitted a reference to one ward (No. 23) of the District of South Oxfordshire. This Order corrects that omission.
