The Social Security (Child Benefit Consequential) **Amendment Regulations 1977**

Made -7th March 1977 Laid before Parliament 11th March 1977 Coming into Operation 4th April 1977

The Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 35(1) and (5) of the Social Security Act 1975(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations which contain no provisions other than such as are made in consequence of the Child Benefit Act 1975(b):-

Citation, interpretation and commencement

1. These regulations, which may be cited as the Social Security (Child Benefit Consequential) Amendment Regulations 1977, shall be read as one with the Social Security (Child Benefit Consequential) Regulations 1977(c) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") and shall come into operation on 4th April 1977.

Amendment of regulation 15 of the principal regulations

- 2. Regulation 15 of the principal regulations (which makes consequential amendments to the Social Security (Attendance Allowance) (No. 2) Regulations 1975(d)) shall be amended in accordance with the following provisions of this regulation—
 - (a) in paragraph (2) before the words "for paragraph (2)" there shall be inserted the words "for the words '10A of the Family Allowances (Qualifications) Regulations 1969, as amended (certain persons exempt from United Kingdom income tax)' in sub-paragraph (f) of paragraph (1), there shall be substituted the words '9 of the Child Benefit (General) Regulations 1976(e), as amended (f) (persons exempt from tax)' and";

(b) in paragraph (3) before the words "for sub-paragraph (ii)" there shall be inserted the words "the words from 'so however that' to the end of paragraph (1)(a) shall be omitted and"; and after the word "payable" in sub-paragraph (ii) as so substituted there shall be inserted the words "in respect of the child".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations are made in consequence of the Child Benefit Act 1975 under which, with effect from 4th April 1977, family allowances under the Family Allowances Acts 1965 to 1975 are replaced by child benefit.

The Regulations contain no provisions which are not made in consequence of the Child Benefit Act 1975 and accordingly, by virtue of section 21(6) of that Act, they are exempt from the requirements of sections 139(1) and 141(2) of the Social Security Act 1975 (requirement to refer proposals to advisory bodies) and no reference has been made to those bodies

The Regulations amend the Social Security (Child Benefit Consequential) Regulations 1977 ("the Principal Regulations"). Regulation 1 is formal; and regulation 2 remedies omissions in regulation 15 of the Principal Regulations.
