# The Legal Advice and Assistance (Financial Conditions) (No. 2) Regulations 1977

Made ---3rd February 1977Laid before Parliament15th February 1977Coming into Operation1st April 1977

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 1 and 20 of the Legal Aid Act 1974(a), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Advice and Assistance (Financial Conditions) (No. 2) Regulations 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1977.
- (2) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, "the Act" means the Legal Aid Act 1974 and other expressions have the same meaning as in that Act.
- (3) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. For the weekly sum of £35 specified in section 1(1)(a) of the Act, as amended by the Legal Advice and Assistance (Financial Conditions) (No. 2) Regulations 1976(c), there shall be substituted the weekly sum of £42.
