Act of Sederunt (Fees of Sheriff Officers) 1977

Made -25th March 1977 Laid before Parliament 5th April 1977 2nd May 1977 Coming into Operation

The Lords of Council and Session, under and by virtue of the powers conferred on them by section 40 of the Sheriff Courts (Scotland) Act 1907(a), section 6 of the Execution of Diligence (Scotland) Act 1926(b), and section 34 of the Administration of Justice (Scotland) Act 1933(c), and of all other powers competent to them in that behalf, do hereby enact and declare:-

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Fees of Sheriff Officers) 1977 and shall come into operation on 2nd May 1977.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) applies to the interpretation of this Act of Sederunt as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

New fees

2. The fees specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Act of Sederunt are the fees payable to Sheriff Officers in respect of the matters specified opposite them in column 1 of the Schedule, and are so payable from the date this Act of Sederunt comes into operation.

Revocation

3. The Act of Sederunt (Fees of Sheriff Officers) 1975(e) is revoked.

The foregoing Table of Fees relates to work executed between normal business hours, i.e. 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.

Diligence or Citation which of necessity is executed after 5.00 p.m. and before 10.00 p.m.—additional 33\frac{1}{3} per cent to be added. (extra-judicial)

Service of Citation or Diligence which of necessity requires execution after 10.00 p.m. and before 9.00 a.m. or on Saturdays or Public Holidays, additional 75 per cent to be added to fee. (extra-judicial)

When the Officer has to cross a Ferry he will be allowed the necessary cost of the Ferry, and for mileage to charge the breadth of the Ferry and one-half more.

Unless by special arrangement the charges for mileage shall be calculated according to either the distance between the Court House where the Warrant granted and the place of Execution or the distance between the nearest Sheriff Officer's place of business within the County and the place of Execution, whichever shall be the lesser.
