WATER, ENGLAND AND WALES

The Southern Water Authority (Whitwell Borehole) Order 1977

Made - - - 23rd May 1977
Coming into Operation 8th June 1977

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Southern Water Authority (Whitwell Borehole) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 8th June 1977. Citation and commencement.

(2) The Southern Water Authority Orders 1975 and 1976 and this order may be cited together as the Southern Water Authority Orders 1975 to 1977.

2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires— Interpretation.

“the Authority” means the Southern Water Authority;

“the deposited plan” means the plan prepared in duplicate signed by an Under Secretary in the Department of the Environment and marked “Plan referred to in the Southern Water Authority (Whitwell Borehole) Order 1977”, one duplicate of which is deposited and is available for inspection at the offices of the Chief Solicitor to the Authority and the other at the offices of the Secretary of State for the Environment;

“the land” means the land described in Schedule 1 to this order;

“the Third Schedule” means the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945;

“the undertaking” means the water undertaking of the Authority as for the time being authorised by any enactment.

3. For the purposes of this order, the provisions of the Third Schedule which are specified in column (1) of Schedule 2 to this order shall, subject to the modifications set out in column (2) of the said Schedule 2 apply to the undertaking and are hereby incorporated with this order. Application of certain provisions of Third Schedule.

4.—(1) The Authority may when they have acquired the necessary land or sufficient rights therein— Construction and maintenance of works.

(a) construct and maintain a borehole on or under the land,

(b) construct and maintain on or under the said land (in addition to the works authorised by section 4 of the Third Schedule as applied to the undertaking by this order) all such wells, boreholes, adits and headings as may be necessary or expedient for augmenting or improving the supply of water obtainable by means of the said borehole.

(2) The works authorised by this order shall for all purposes form part of the undertaking.

SCHEDULE 1

LAND ON OR UNDER WHICH WORKS MAY BE CONSTRUCTED AND MAINTAINED UNDER THIS ORDER

Land at Whitwell forming part of parcels numbered 75 and 302 in the Parish of Niton in the Borough of South Wight on the 1/2500 ordnance map of Hampshire (IOW) sheet numbered XCVIII 14 (edition of 1908) comprising 2,600 sq. metres or thereabouts and more particularly delineated and coloured red on the deposited plan.
