The Local Review Committee (Scotland) Amendment Rules 1978

Made - - - - 1st September 1978

Laid before Parliament 14th September 1978

Coming into Operation 6th October 1978

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 59(6) of the Criminal Justice Act 1967(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following rules:—

- 1.—(1) These rules may be cited as the Local Review Committee (Scotland) Amendment Rules 1978 and shall come into operation on 6th October 1978.
- (2) In these rules the expression "the principal rules" means the Local Review Committee (Scotland) Rules 1967(b) as amended(c).
 - 2. The principal rules shall be amended as follows:—
 - (a) In rule 9 for the words "section 57 of the Children and Young Persons (Scotland) Act 1937(d) (young persons convicted of grave crimes)" there shall be substituted the words "section 206 of the Criminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1975(e) (punishment of persons under 18)";
 - (b) "Shotts prison" shall be added to the Schedule to the principal rules; and
 - (c) "Barlinnie young offenders institution" shall be deleted from the said Schedule.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules amend the Local Review Committee (Scotland) Rules 1967 by removing from the Schedule specifying certain prisons and young offenders institutions at which local review committees are to be established the entry in respect of Barlinnie young offenders institution and by adding an entry in respect of Shotts prison.

Further minor amendment consequential on the passing of the Criminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1975 is also made.
